

KIDS & YOUTH ART GRANT 2017

Overview

Are you 17 years or younger and coming to Burning Seed this year? Do you have an awesome idea that will encourage other kids and youth to participate and make art with you? If so, the Artery is pleased to offer a new **\$500 grant** for a Kids/Youth art project at [Burning Seed 2017](#) (taking place Sept 27th to Oct 2nd).

Applications are open until **July 30th 2017 at 6 p.m.** Anyone aged 17 and under can apply for the funding and we will get back to you within a week of the deadline about your project and if we will fund it. Depending on the number of applications we may only be able to offer partial grants or may suggest that applicants work together if project submissions have similar ideas.

We're looking for projects that....

- Encourage participation of both younger kids and youth/teens
- Are partially or fully created on site
- Have a reasonable budget
- Will be Leave No Trace and consider how to be MOOP free
- Use recycled or upcycled materials and contributions from Kids Camp members
- Have a safety plan, making sure the piece is lit up at night and that it's not dangerous
- Have considered what will happen to the piece at the end of the event

Depending on the project you may also think about

- If you want it to be displayed as a piece on the open paddock and when it will be finished, or maybe you'll just have it within Kids Camp (we're bending our art rules for this one!)
- If it's a mobile project consider having a parade to show it off and list it as an event in the WWW guide
- Burning it! Depending on the size of the piece and the materials that are used we may be able to let you burn it and add it to the Man burn Saturday or Temple burn Sunday noting that if we can accommodate this that the piece may have to be broken down and would need to be added to the burn site many hours before we fire up, for safety reasons it is not possible to add art to fires that are already burning until many hours after ignition and could only be performed by adults and members of our Fire Art Safety Team (FART).
