1	Casual camping, unknown occupants	Yellow	19	This area was not a registered theme camp, yet is worth noting because it contained a sizeable amount of MOOP and cigarette butts. Who was this?
2	Swing Dog Circus	Yellow	26	SDS covered a very large area, so 26 butts isn't really that bad (comparitively). Surprised at the amount of MOOP given that they are very strong advcates of Leave No Trace, and the MOOP Troupe do want to recognise that they did a supreme job of watching over the area around the toilet block near Centre Camp, as well as locating and taking care of a number of places where human faeces were discovered in the woods behind their camp. I really want to give them Green, but the volume speaks for itself... lots of small objects, plus seven tent pegs (two large ones) which is probably what tipped them over from Green into Yellow.
3	Cloud Cuckoo Land	Green	2	Just a few bits and bobs.
4	Alkazar Riffle	Green	4	A few more bits and bobs.
5	Purple Turtle	Green	0	Supreme effort from the Turtles. Only a couple of zipties and miscellaneous tiny things overlooked. Clearly done some MOOP sweeps before they left.
6	Trash Mansion	Green	19	Good effort from the Trashies in view of having such a roaring theme camp this year. Clearly stepped up their MOOP sweeps compared to the last few years.
7	Detox	Green	1	A small non-registered theme camp. Spotless apart from a couple of tiny things, from memory one old bottle cap and a piece of string.
8	Alien Welcoming Committee	Green	6	We watched AWWV doing *very* detailed grid sweeps and they were passionate about Leaving No Trace. The evidence (or lack thereof) proves that. Well done. They are also talking about having a separated smoking area at their camp next year!
9	Shaky Hands	Green	N/A	Situated near Centre Camp, these fullas did a good job packing down and clearing out. Were they even here?
10	Coastal Bass Initiative	N/A	N/A	Sad face. This camp did not make it through the event intact and was not recorded for the MOOP Map.
11	Beta Stage / Burning Dragon	Red	58	Some poor communication regarding pack-out transportation of garbage, and a hot fire place in the middle of the dance floor area that required a fire hose to douse, left a bad taste in our mouths. A veritable bucket of ciggie butts across the whole site, plus numerous tiny bits of MOOP. Oh, dear.
12	Sum Rhythm City	N/A	N/A	This camp was not at the Burn due to organisational challenges.
13	Funmaker Silent Disco	N/A	N/A	This camp was not at the Burn due to organisational challenges.
14	Disco Nebula	N/A	N/A	This camp was not at the Burn due to organisational challenges. A couple of star pickets found out here in the paddock, but not sure how long they have been there.
15	Sunset Island	Green	3	Very clean site given how large and how busy the camp was, well done.
16	Middle Eastern Mafia	Green	3	Grid sweeps done, very little MOOP, just a few miscellaneous tiny things. MEM almost got pinged with a yellow mark due to casual camping neighbours leaving a bunch of MOOP behind. This is a good moment to reiterate the principle of doing grid sweeps to a ten-meter radius around your camp. We are a community!
17	Pelican Villa	Yellow	52	2 tent pegs were recovered, along with loose plastic bags, miscellaneous bits of plastic and glitter, fake leaves, and citrus peels. PV tell us that they did do MOOP sweeps, so we really wonder what went wrong here.
18	Star Shitty	Yellow	9	A fake kiwi left at the gate, lots of astro turf, several tent pegs, and an unregistered open fire place which, lucky for them, was cold. This is basically a Yellow+.
19	Pirania	EMERALD	0	Utterly spotless, not a hair out of place. MOOP GODS!
20	Opti Doof Gif Room	Green	12	At this site we recovered a large number of tiny pieces of red carpeting thread. Almost impossible to MOOP up and a testament to how large items made of tiny pieces can get away on you. Did they join Star Shitty.
21	Deja	Green	6	Misc. tiny things including stick-on bindi thingees and sequins.
22	Kurmaraja	Green	11	A few food scraps and tiny things.
23	Feastureyez	Green	10	Various tiny things, bottle caps, and plastic water container seals.
24	Evolver Lounge	Green / Red	17	While the core Evolver Lounge crew departed site on Tuesday, a number of hangers-on (mostly newbie Burners) occupied the Evolver site for two more days while the shade structure was waiting for collection by a hire company. Not knowing that they were not officially connected with Evolver Lounge, the MOOP Troupe initially gave this site a Red status as on Thursday morning there was a very hot fire place left behind, along with a red rug, broken camp chair, and open compost pit with a number of large food items in it. This experience serves as a reminder
25	Kamp Kraken	Green	8	Kraken covered a large grid area and thus only 8 ciggie butts is an excellent result. 3 further butts on the camp's far outer fringes on the BeBop side were not counted. Misc tiny items, few bits of string and red carpet material. We also covered the Phoenix area separately as it was something of a congregation point with its nest, there were 2 further butts. Fire barrel very clean with only one butt counted there. Generally a very clean site, obviously they have done some intensive MOOP sweeps.
26	Morning Joint	Green	7	A few misc tiny things and a grommet. Not much to report.
27	Malt Shop Be Bop Hip Hop Roller Arena	Green	0	Not a butt to be found, and a pretty clean site. A few bottle caps and tiny things, not much else.

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28	Coco Poco Loco	Green	4	Located mainly behind Morning Joint next to Bean Bag, there were very few ciggie butts but a number of spots with tiny grassy-looking shreds of astro turf about. On investigation it seems that CPL will need to tape up their seams better next time they're on the paddock. We found the turf strewn all across the entire site, possibly because their Loco-Motive was mobile. As there were a few camps (Mint Country Club and Star Shitty spring to mind) who used astro turf this year, we will be bringing this item up again in future educational discussions.
29	Bean Bag Babylon	Green / Yellow	40	Having initially signed BBB off with not much found, conducting wider and more detailed sweeps as a team revealed a decent number of ciggie butts. Totally a green status, however next year we will need to demark theme camp areas more accurately, as the Bean Bag crew are amongst the most staunch proponents of Leave No Trace at Burning Seed and the only way they would have left this number of butts was if the area to be checked was not well communicated. Most of these butts were found on the outer fringes of the theme camp space, many of them past where the burn barrel was located. Difficult to ping BBB with this one, so we'll stick with Green and take it as a lesson for next year.
30	Blending Seed	Green	0	Very little moop, couple of plastic utensils along the road frontage and ZERO butts. Very happy with this site, super-close to becoming Moop Gods.
31	Dirty Birds	Green	17	Damn close to yellow. Misc small things, bottle caps, looks like they have done MOOP checks but not detailed sweeps. Some broken styrofoam, rear of the camp, have not mooped much further back into the woods. We found some stuff off to the left and rear of the camp that was missed, and this reinforces the point that next year we need to encourage theme camps to MOOP to a 10m radius around their site.
32	Nargile Temple	Green	8	Even after I had checked over this site with the rest of my camp here, during follow-up sweeps the MOOP Troupe found 8 ciggie butts and a fw more miscellaneous tiny things. You have to look hard, people! Even the best of us miss things. :-)
33	Mint Country Club	Green	4	Hardcore MOOPers. Swept up glitter from the dirt into rubbish bags and carted it off -- exemplary dedication to the cause. One of their golf clubs was found behind a tree on the other side of the road from camp.
34	Orphanage	Green	5	Tent pegs, misc tiny things, couple of yellow feathers, little bit of glitter.
35	Telekenetic Chair Repair	Green	6	Flouro water-based paint flecks scattered around the area.
36	Kettle Tea House	Green	6	Clearly done detailed grid sweeps over the site. Just a few tiny bits of string and a bit of glitter in a few spots.
37	Lamplighters and Hardware	Green	0	Couple of tiny bits of cotton thread were the only Moop. Not a single ciggie butt! Completely butt-naked. Beautiful.
38	Spoonology	Green	5	Area behind theme camp site with a large amount of gold glitter and silver tinsel on the cryptogamic crust, impossible to clean up. Also a large amount of food waste on the ground - pistachio shells, citrus peels, sunflower seed shells, banana skins. Small amount of general plastics laying around. People not associated with Spoonology have left behind three whole hard boiled eggs. Go wider, people!
39	Best Place at Burning Seed	Green	5	Pretty clean :-)
40	Polynation	Green	2	Nothing much to report, some miscellaneous tiny things, way less than a teacup's worth.
41	Threshold	Green	4	As with PolyNation, only a few butts and some tiny things like water container seals.
42	Soupery	EMERALD	0	MOOP GODS. How did you do it? Looks like the soil was licked clean!
43	Gypsy Kitchen	Green	12	Unregistered theme camp who took a while to pack down but left the place in pretty good nick.
44	Jasmine Underground	Yellow	47	At least one person has really let the side down. In one tent spot a coat hanger, some feathers, a feather tied to a tree, quite a lot of glitter, tent pegs, bottle tops, can tabs, various bits of junks. Dangerously close to 2L and a red mark. Loads of ciggie butts all through the forest.
45	Kids Kamp	Green / Red	0	A few tent pegs and a bunch of glitter from the gorgeous bunyip they made. Rookie mistake, guys.
46	Crimson tent	Green	1	Some misc tiny things, nothing crazy.
47	A Little Bit of Magic	Green	2	Nothing out of control, a couple of bottle caps and tiny things.
48	Red Earth Brewery	Green	13	For the amount of boozing that went down here there was hardly any evidence. A few misc tiny things, and nothing that made you think it was nay more than casual camping. Nice work, folks.
49	Queertopia	Green	2	A number of cable ties recovered here.
50	Sunday Bloody Mary	Green	7	Miscellaneous tiny things, nothing of specific note.
	Casual Camping Results			
	Casual camping near Threshold	Hotspot	18	Matches and ciggie butts in one place, possible link to the guys from Sydney. Near Threshold, casual camping near Muse-Ambique Road.
	Quieter Camping (wider area)	Hotspot	7	Tent pegs, black elastic strapping, cable ties, just into the woods at back of camping area north side of East Road in quieter camping. 75m past Gypsy Kitchen.
	To right of entrance to Soupery	Hotspot	13	A bunch of casual campers left a MOOP hotspot behind. Glitter, matches and ciggie butts in one spot, possible link to bunch of firs-time burners from Sydney.

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	Woods at north of site	Hotspot		At least one instance of human faeces in the forest north of (but not associated with) Cloud Cuckoo Land. Numerous other reports from nearby theme camps of them finding and digging over faeces left on the top of the ground and toilet paper strewn through the forest. WTF!!
	250m east from the East Road fork, north side off the road	Hotspot		Two AA batteries and several small button batteries, 5 ciggie butts, 4 glo-stick joiners, 2 rubber bands, and a tent packing string. All within a 1m radius.
	Total ciggie butts recovered from casual camping areas AND the central paddock		117	Ciggie butts were recovered wherever we went. Bottle caps, water container seals, can stubs, and tent pegs were also found across the entire site.
	Overall			For the number of people we had this year I was actually pretty impressed. The places where we found stuff in concentration were just pockets, usually in casual camping areas. Theme camps generally did extremely well, given the amount of traffic they had. The area of casual camping to the west of the main site was sparsely scattered with miscellaneous tiny things - glitter, tent pegs, thos stick-on bindi rhinestone things were *everywhere*, and the usual bottle caps, water container seals and can stubs. The area of woods to the south was peppered with baby wipes; the woods to the north were reportedly a hotbed of steaming turds; and quit(er) camping to the east was garnished with small slices of try-harder in a yummy grandma-baked cake of loveliness and kittens. All in all, a pretty good job from this year's Burner tribe, and I came away happy even though we have LOTS of things to bring up before next year's burn!
	Items of special note			A significant number of feathers, glitter in seven different places, loads of those stick-on bindi rhinestone things were bloody *everywhere*, and bits of astro truf and red carpet material were found from one end of the site to the other.

	Centre Camp	Green	3	Very clean, good job.
	Rangers / Medical (Woop Woop)	Red	2	Two sleepers, some 2x4 wood, and a star picket. Well over a top hat's worth of MOOP left behind by the Burning Seed organisation.
	Effigy Burn Site	Green	12	Incredibly clean overall. Various tiny things, bottle caps, etc but no remaining nails or fasteners from the effigy itself were recovered.
	Temple Burn site	Red	12	Various tiny things, bottle caps, etc. The burn site was still covered with ash, a dozen wooden stakes, and several fasteners.
	Stockade / DPI	Red		A medium sized pallet and a large compost pit containing ash and unburnt items comprising well over a top hat's worth of MOOP. Some important lessons for DPI to learn before next year's Burn rolls around.
	Toilets	Yellow		Numerous pieces of toilet paper, soiled undies, loo rolls, sundry garbage. All four toilet blocks were a bit MOOP-y.
