### **Team Description**

Centre Camp at Burning Seed is gifted to the community by a small but dedicated team who passionately believe it is their civic responsibility to create a 'living room' where everyone is radically included to participate in acts of immediacy, from spontaneous cuddle puddles to lycra clad leapfrog.

This is the centre of the universe – the hub of red earth city, where we welcome radical self expression, and above all participation. If you are looking for a way to make new friends and get involved find the crew wranglers at Centre Camp and they will advise you on the best way you can gift your time and skills to our community.

As well as enabling a hive of activity, Centre Camp is designed to be a neutral nurturing space co-created for the people by the people to facilitate communal effort, collaboration, and the exchange of information.

### **Role Summary/Purpose:**

Centre Camp Guardians will be the protectors of Centre Camp and will take an active role in maintaining the space. Guardians will work closely with the Centre Camp Team Leads in managing the space, facilitating workshops and ensuring our home is always welcoming and open. Liaising with participants who will use the space to hold a variety of events in the lead up, during and after Burning Seed.

### **Time Commitment/Dates required:**

- Year Round: 1 hour per month
- On Site: 2-3 hours per shift (ideally min 3 shifts per person)
- Post-event: 5-6 hours packdown

### **Duties/Responsibilities**

Undertake tasks as directed by the Centre Camp Team Lead, to achieve the event planning and execution, which may include:

- Engaging and liaising with performers and facilitators on arrival and during the event
- Provide participants with general event-related information and answer questions
- Assessing Centre Camp operations during the event
- Working to keep Centre a clean and tidy environment
- Help with monitoring Centre Camp packdown and assisting the MOOP team
- Engage with the community and encourage use of the space
- Undertake tasks as directed by Team Leads
