Role Summary/Purpose: General FART members form the majority of the Fire Art Response Team, Burning Seeds emergency fire department. Less experienced members will be trained and mentored during the event.

- Kit out team with appropriate personal protective clothing.
- Train new members for leadership roles.
- Establish working process for managing and inspecting flammable art
