Team Description

The Entry Fluffers are a crew of performers making the most of the gate wait time to deliver important safety and Burning Seed cultural information in a fun and interactive way.

Role Summary/Purpose:

When there is a queue of cars, they will be based at the Gate and in the lanes of people waiting to get to gate. The Fluffers are responsible for pre-Gate education/operational communication to the line up of cats and cars. This includes, pre-filtering before Gate to put people in the correct line (have tickets ready, have ID etc), enculturation information, and indoctrination about the 10 principles to take pressure off Greeters (which should be more of a ceremony than education). Where there isn't a queue, they will be based at Greeters to do the same.

Major team projects for 2017:

- Create Performance CONTENT, such as:
 - Skits
 - Songs
 - Interviews
 - Spoken Word
 - Physical Theatre
 - Dance
 - Pranks

Based around the 10/11 principles. These can be individual or group projects.

- Devise personal performance / presentation style.
- Understand and convey key elements of Burning Seed culture.
