Team: LEAVE NO TRACE

Department: Operations

Dates Required: 2-3 days post-event

Shift Length: 8 hrs/day

Number of Shifts: 2

Ideal Skills: Strong walking legs and a good eye; experience with creating online presentations; communication and writing skills; good-to-excellent computer literacy; cartography experience; OR - a willingness to learn all of these skills in any basic sense.

Training Provided: a comprehensive brief on how to complete the deliverable (Map).

Amenities Provided: On days you work while on site, you will be provided with 3 prepared meals a day.

Team Description:

We return the paddock to its former glory and keep a record of how well each theme camp upholds the LNT principle.

We educate our community on how we can leave no trace of our activities and festivities at Matong State Forest.

In doing so we support participants to practice self-reliance and civic responsibility.

Role Description:

You will be central to the creation of the MOOP Map – a report of findings from the MOOP Sweep Teams on how much MOOP is left behind by us all after the Burn is said and done.

As a map's creator, you will have a fair whack of artistic license in the presentation of this year's MOOP data. The Map just needs to be web-based, graphical, intuitive, and simple.

You will need to be on the ground as part of the Sweep Teams when we're collecting the data, recording with photo, audio and video any details you think will give the map impact or serve to get the LNT gospel across.

You'll also help the LNT Team Lead to present the map when it's done on social media and in the LNT Afterburn Report.

The Map will need to be completed no later than three weeks after the close of Burning Seed.

Some follow up with theme camps or Burning Seed team leads may be required to ensure that the data you present is fair and accurate. Sometimes a little personal tact is necessary!
