### **Team Description:**

The Sanitation Team organises and maintains all the toilets for the event and manages the DPI waste. We coordinate with external contractors to make this happen efficiently and effectively to provide the best sanitation services any burn has ever seen.

### **Role Description:**

As the Sanitation Team Lead, it's your job to provide the best possible sanitation solutions for Burning Seed. You'll need to ensure every participant has access to safe, reliable and environmentally friendly toilets. To do this, you'll have a crew of dedicated volunteers to help you on the paddock and the full support of the Department of Planning and Infrastructure.

You'll negotiate contracts with local suppliers of toilets, water and sewage, and ensure we have the right people on crew and manage the system during the event. The outgoing Sanitation Lead, Squeaky Queen, will always be available for guidance and support.

It's not the most glamorous role, but that's not why you're here. You want the satisfaction that no one will be traumatised by having to poop in a scummy loo, be forced to out into the wilderness for a comfortable crap or end up lying in their tent sick as a dog.

Without you, Burning Seed would just be a pile of shit. Thanks for taking on this significant role. You will be rewarded.
