

Red Earth City is a bicycle and pedestrian-oriented city. Other than driving to your campsite once you're through Gate/Greeters, there is no driving on site allowed other than with a registered mutant vehicle. The use of non mutated vehicles for tasks like carrying water or ice to camps is prohibited.

Anyone driving at Burning Seed must adhere to all REC driving rules. These include:

- Only drive vehicles licensed or allowed to drive in Red Earth City. Non mutated vehicles will not be licensed.
- Mutant vehicles may only be operated in the configuration they have been licensed for, i.e. no operation of tow vehicle without trailer if licensed with a trailer.
- **Drive at a speed of 5 km/h or less (less in hazardous situations such as tight crowds)**
- Give the right of way to pedestrians, bicycles, and emergency services vehicles
- **Stop immediately upon being hailed by any Ranger, REDMV or police**
- **No driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol**
- No driving on wet or freshly-watered roads
- Obey applicable sound policies
- Create a clear field of vision for the operator
- Have ground guides (walkers) if required by REDMV i.e min. 1 walker each side
- Have a safe access area and procedures for loading and unloading passengers
- Provide a door-person/gatekeeper if necessary for all vehicles where people may be tempted to board/de-board of their own accord
- Clearly display the Mutant Vehicle license in a location specified by the REDMV
- Only drive to the conditions of your license (i.e. day time only)
- **No loading or unloading of passengers while the vehicle is moving**

**Breach of conditions in bold will result in immediate revocation of your license.**

**Your license to operate a Mutant Vehicle is conditional upon adherence to the above guidelines. Licenses can be revoked at any time (even a first offense, if sufficiently offensive) by any site manager, team lead, Ranger shift lead, REDMV, Forestry or law enforcement personnel.**

**Your REDMV license applies to the vehicle and all operators - i.e. if your license is revoked, the vehicle is grounded; nobody else can operate it either.**
