

Red Earth City is a bicycle and pedestrian-oriented city. Other than driving to your campsite once you're through Gate/Greeters, there is no driving on site allowed other than with a registered mutant vehicle. The use of non mutated vehicles for tasks like carrying water or ice to camps is prohibited.

Key road rules:

- **Drive at a speed of 8 km/h or less (less in tight crowds or hazardous situations).**
- **Stop immediately upon being hailed by any ranger, traffic officer, RedMV, or police.**
- **Do not drive under the influence of drugs or alcohol.**
- **Do not load or unload passengers while the vehicle is moving.**

Other road rules:

- Give the right of way to pedestrians, bicycles, and emergency service vehicles
- Mutant vehicles may only be operated by drivers with a licence valid in Australia.
- No driving on wet or freshly-watered roads.
- Driving is only allowed on designated roads except for Emergency vehicles and Operational vehicles responding to an incident.
- A licensed Mutant Vehicle may drive off a designated road using the shortest and safest route to a destination where they can park, stay and PLAY! Before leaving the location, they must MOOP the area to leave no trace and take the shortest and safest route back to the designated road.
- Mutant vehicles may only be operated in the configuration they have been licensed for, i.e. no operation of tow vehicle without trailer if licensed with a trailer.
- Mutant vehicles drivers must follow all conditions of their mutant vehicle licence, these may include:
 - Only operating day and/or night.
 - Following safe access procedures for boarding.
 - Having a door person ensuring boarding is done safely.
 - Having agreed number of guides/walkers communicating with the driver
- Obey applicable sound policies.
- Clearly display the Mutant Vehicle license in a location specified by the RedMV and point it out to any authorised person when asked.

Your license to operate a Mutant Vehicle is conditional upon adherence to the above guidelines. Licenses can be revoked at any time (even a first offense, if sufficiently dangerous) by any site manager, team lead, ranger shift lead, RedMV, forestry or law enforcement personnel.

Your RedMV license applies to the vehicle and all operators - i.e. if your license is revoked, the vehicle is grounded; nobody else can operate it either.

Enforcement:

- **Breach of any key road rules (in bold) may result in immediate revocation of your license.**
- The person who registered the vehicle is responsible for it at all times, regardless of who is driving.
- Breaking of the driving rules or other unsafe behaviour may result in the vehicle being grounded for some or all of the event.
- Serious incidents or extremely unsafe behaviour may result in people involved being ejected from the event.
- RedMV reserves the right to impose additional conditions at any time.
- RedMV reserves the right to revoke a mutant vehicle license at any time.
